Programme Structure:

Students reading the BBA curriculum are required to take a total of 240 credits within four years of study.

UG5 Requirements (54 credits)	 UG5 Requirements: (i) English language enhancement (12 credits); (ii) Chinese language enhancement (6 credits); and (iii) Common Core Courses (36 credits). CAES1000 Core University English and Chinese language course: please check the exemption criteria in the application form and apply by the deadline. Common Core Courses: complete 36 credits (6 courses) comprising at least one and more than two courses from each Area of Inquiry (AoI) with not more than 24 credits of courses being selected within one academic year except where candidates are required to make up for failed credits.
Compulsory Major (72 credits)	 Opt for one of the following majors at the beginning of 2nd year: (i) Business Design and Innovation (BDI)[*]; (ii) Human Resource Management (HRM); (iii) Information Systems (IS); (iv) Marketing; or (v) Wealth Management. For each major (72 credits), you have to complete: (i) Faculty Core Courses (24 credits); (ii) Business Core Courses (24 credits); and (iii) Disciplinary Courses (24 credits), according to your chosen major.
Free Electives (114 credits)	Free electives are courses except Common Core Courses. May utilize these 114 and its of free electives for an antique major and/or minor.
Other Graduation Requirements	 May utilise these 114 credits of free electives for an optional major and/or minor. Mandatory English Proficiency Test at two different junctures: (i) Entry Test in Year 1; and (ii) Exit Test in your final year of study.
