



## Bachelor of Business and Administration (Information Systems) [BBA(IS)]

### Programme Structure:

Students reading the BBA(IS) curriculum are required to take a total of 240 credits within four years of study.

<b>UG5 Requirements (54 credits)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>UG5 Requirements: (i) English language enhancement (12 credits); (ii) Chinese language enhancement (6 credits); and (iii) Common Core Courses (36 credits).</li> <li>CAES1000 Core University English and Chinese language course: please check the exemption criteria in the application form and apply by the deadline.</li> <li>Students must complete a total of 36 credits of Common Core Courses, comprising at least one and more than two courses from each Area of Inquiry (AoI) with not more than 24 credits of courses being selected within one academic year except where candidates are required to make up for failed credits.</li> </ul>
<b>Compulsory 1<sup>st</sup> Major (72 credits) and 2<sup>nd</sup> Major (84 credits)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Compulsory: (i) 1<sup>st</sup> major in Information Systems (72 credits); and (ii) 2<sup>nd</sup> major in Computer Science (84 credits).</li> <li>At the beginning of 2<sup>nd</sup> year, you have to declare the compulsory majors on SIS by yourself.</li> <li>Faculty Core Courses can <u>only</u> be double counted across <u>major-major</u>, but <u>not</u> major-minor combination.</li> <li>Double-counting is NOT allowed for courses <i>other than</i> Faculty Core Courses. Students have to take an equivalent number of credits of disciplinary elective (advanced level) in lieu of the overlapped courses.</li> </ul>
<b>Free Electives (30 credits)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Free electives are courses except Common Core Courses.</li> </ul>
<b>Other Graduation Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All FBE students are required to take an English Proficiency Test at two different junctures: (i) Entry Test in <u>Year 1</u>; and (ii) Exit Test in your <u>final year</u> of study.</li> </ul>
<b>Important Note</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students are required to take courses following the order of study indicated in the Regulations and Syllabuses: <a href="http://www.fbe.hku.hk/academic-programmes/undergraduate/bba-is">http://www.fbe.hku.hk/academic-programmes/undergraduate/bba-is</a></li> <li>Study load: at least 60 credits of course in an academic year. Prior approval is needed should you wish to pursue credit overload and/or underload in any academic year.</li> </ul>
